There is still time to get your youngster signed up. Please see the Rooster Run section in this newsletter for all the information.

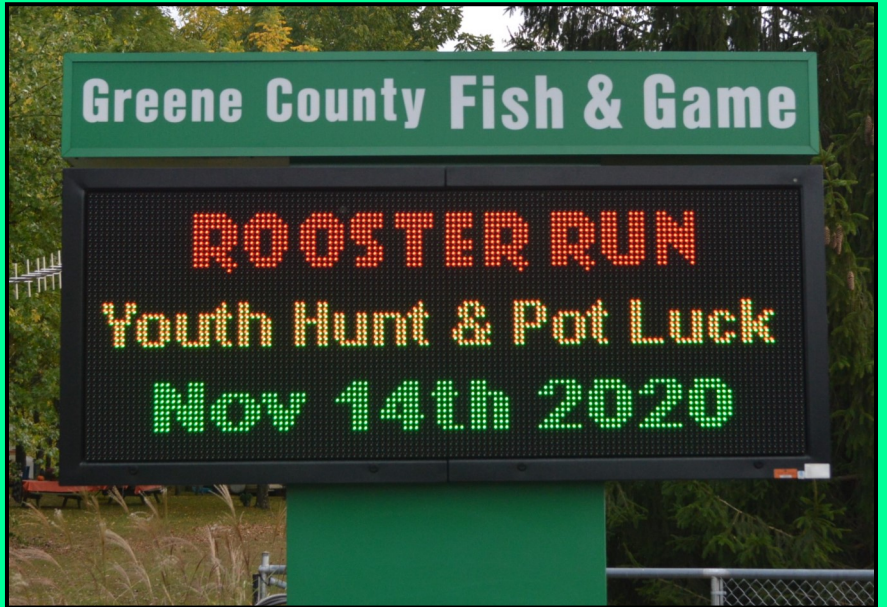
Our youth is the future of Hunting, Fishing, and our club. We need to help them become good, ethical, and safe outdoorsmen and outdoorswomen.

Then all the kids, the group leaders and parents will safely gather in the clubhouse to talk about the experience over a piping hot meal properly served up by members of the Women's Auxiliary.

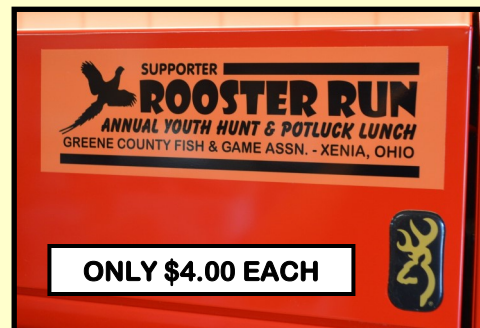
