

There are even some good YouTube videos showing Indoor and Outdoor Range Safety and Range Etiquette including the one published by ODNR for the Spring Valley Shooting Range, NRA and Smith and Wesson, please take some time and watch a few of these.

These Safety Rules are not mere suggestions; ignoring the rules is cause for corrective action including losing your membership. If you bring a guest, you are also responsible for their actions.

If your new to shooting or do not have much Firearm/Range experience, please reach out to me. I would be happy to schedule some time with you or if there is enough interest from others, we can make a day of it.

I'm sure I could get enough Range Officers to help me out. My number one objective as Range Chairman is safety; this cannot be compromised or ignored.
